### 1. Full-time Ph.D. Program

## **Minimum Eligibility:**

- Postgraduate degree in Anthropology, Sociology, Political Science, Economics, English, Philosophy
  or related disciplines, with a minimum 55% mark or CGPA of 6.0 on 10 points. The candidates
  belonging to reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC (NCL), PWD) will be given relaxation as per
  institute norms.
- Must have qualified UGC-JRF/NET/GATE/ or equivalent examination. \*
  - \* Candidates who have completed their BS-MS/M.Sc./MA/MBA/or equivalent postgraduate degrees from IITs, IISERs, IISc, IIMs or any of the top 100 institutes according to NIRF ranking 2025 (overall category) at the time of application will be exempted from the mandatory requirements of qualifying UGC–JRF/NET/GATE/or equivalent examination.

- Minimum two years of work experience (employed in industry/organization having R&D facilities and recognized by DST/IIT Mandi, national laboratories, reputed universities/colleges, or employed in research/analysis jobs in the public or private sector)
- A research scholar under the External Registration Program normally carries out part or all the research work at the place of employment under the supervision of a co-supervisor also employed in the same organization and a supervisor at IIT Mandi.
